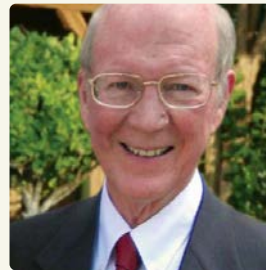
DAVID RIVES has experience in astronomy, paleontology and archaeology which has made him an in-demand speaker on creation versus evolution topics. His powerful and inspirational delivery makes learning about Bible history and

science fun and easy for audiences of all ages. His use of the ministries' observatory class telescopes has resulted in breathtaking astrophotography which has been featured in textbooks and scientific literature. David's weekly TV show *Creation* aims to millions globally on TBN with interviews of leading creation scientists. DR. CHARLES JACKSON, or Dr. J, as he is often called, has degrees in Biology, Environmental Biology and Science Education. He also has a Doctorate of Education in Secondary Science Education from the University of Virginia.

He has been teaching high school and college for over 40 years in the life and physical sciences. Dr. J has been speaking on creation science since the mid-1970's and has spoken and debated on many campuses across the U.S., as well as in Canada, Croatia, Venezuela, Peru and Fiji. Dr. J appeared in the 2017 documentary, *Genesis: Paradise Lost* and figures in a Christian Sci-Fi TV series, *Quantum* (in pre-production). Dr. J's knowledge, humor and engaging speaking style informs and entertains both young and old audiences.



DR. JOBE MARTIN, a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania, was a biology major at Bucknell University and a graduate of the University of Pittsburgh Dental School. After spending two years in the Air Force where he was a dentist for the Presidential

flight crews of Air Force One (the 89th Airlift wing), he established a private dental practice at NASA in Houston, Texas. While a professor at Baylor College of Dentistry, Dr. Martin became a young earth creationist, and after receiving his Masters in Theology, went into full-time ministry with his wife, Jenna Dee, and two daughters, Taryn and Mirren. Their ministry (Biblical Discipleship Ministries) focuses primarily on family discipleship, creation and biblical discernment. **Taryn and Mirren Martin** will lead the grade-school sessions with teaching, games and other activities.

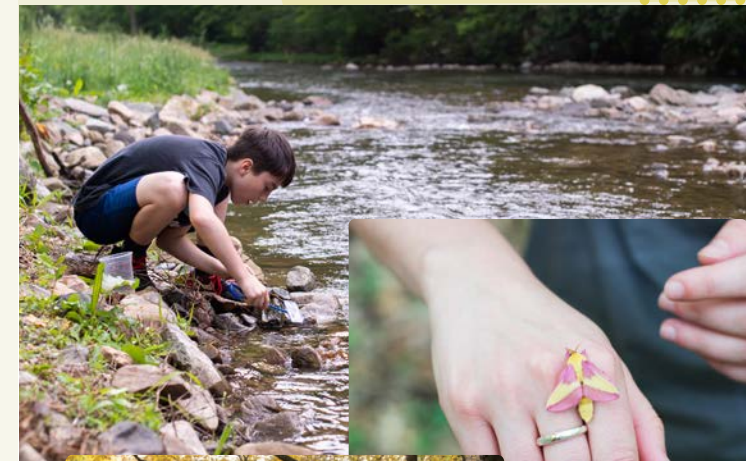

CREATION, SCIENCE AND THE BIBLE

Please join us for a mountain retreat to see and learn about the beauty and design of God's creation. The location is one of the most beautiful places in the southern Appalachian Mountains—Doe River Gorge Ministries, Hampton, Tennessee!

This Christian family conference will include expert lectures on creation, evolution, dinosaurs, birds, reptiles, fossils, astronomy, and the Bible. A field trip in the spectacular Doe River Gorge by way of a narrow-gauge railroad train will focus on the geology and biology of this deep river canyon.

Telescopic viewing of the heavens will be done in the evenings. Live animal presentations will look at the design in birds and reptiles. Teaching will be appropriate for grade-schoolers to adults. Meals, lodging and fun activities are provided by the camp. The cost of lodging can be subtracted for attendees living near the camp and commuting.

ABOUT DOE RIVER GORGE

Doe River Gorge is a Christian camp in the mountains of northeast Tennessee. The year-round camp has been inspiring and equipping people to be passionate followers of Christ for 27 years.

The 400-acre camp includes three miles of narrow gauge railroad track which was once part of the East Tennessee and Western North Carolina Railroad (ET&WNC). This railroad was built in the early 1880's and was affectionately known as the "Tweetsie." Its route through the Appalachian mountains along the Doe River is of exceptional natural beauty.

The ministry operates summer camps, community fun days, a nine-month residential gap year program, father-son retreats, custom events, field trips and outdoor education.

RETREAT REGISTRATION

The registration cost of \$169 (\$119 for ages 6 - 11) includes meals, snacks, coffee breaks, lodging, train ride, activities and lectures. Meals include Thursday dinner, Friday breakfast, lunch and dinner, and Saturday breakfast and lunch. Lodging is in modern rooms with ten bunkbeds and private bathrooms.
